

FRIEND OF 4-H AWARD

The Solano County 4-H Awards Committee wishes to recognize and commend outstanding persons in the communities throughout the county who are not eligible for an Alumni Recognition. Therefore, we hope that each local 4-H Club would submit names to the UCCE Office on or before August 12, 2009.

RULES APPLYING TO “*Friend of 4-H Award*”:

1. Each local Club in Solano County may submit nominations.
2. Nominees may be either male or female and must be over 21 years of age.
3. Once the nominee has received the “*Friend of 4-H Award*” in Solano County, he/she is no longer eligible for said award.
4. The winner of the award will be selected by a “*Friend of 4-H*” committee chosen by the Solano County 4-H Awards Committee
5. Nominee for “*Friend of 4-H Award*” shall not be a bona fide 4-H Leader, parent, member, or advisor.
